RULES AND REGULATIONS

- I. Rules and Regulations for the Government of Sewerage Utilities, adopted by the Public Service Commission of West Virginia, and now in effect, and all amendments thereto and modifications thereof hereafter made by said Commission.

APPLICABILITY

Applicable within the entire territory served

AVAILABILITY

Available for general domestic, commercial and industrial sewer service

(I) RATE (Customers with metered water supply)

First	2,000 gallons used per month	\$16.76 per 1,000 gallons
Next	3,000 gallons used per month	\$ 6.38 per 1,000 gallons
All Over	5,000 gallons used per month	\$ 5.61 per 1,000 gallons

(I) MINIMUM CHARGE

No bill will be rendered for less than \$33.52 per month, which is the equivalent of 2,000 gallons.

(I) FLAT RATE CHARGE (Customers with non-metered water supply)

Equivalent of 4,500 gallons of water usage, \$49.47 per month

DELAYED PAYMENT PENALTY

The above charge is net on all accounts not paid in full within twenty (20) days of the billing cycle. Ten percent (10%) will be added to the amount owed. This delayed payment penalty is not interest and is to be collected only once for each bill where appropriate.

TAP FEE

The following charge is to be made whenever the utility installs a new tap to serve an applicant.

A tap fee of \$500.00 will be charged to all customers who apply for service outside of a certificate proceeding before the Commission for each new tap to the system.

RETURNED CHECK CHARGE

A service charge equal to the actual fee assessed to the Utility or a maximum of \$25.00 will be imposed upon any customer whose check for payment of charges is returned by their bank due to insufficient funds.

(I) Indicates increase

LEAK ADJUSTMENT INCREMENT

\$1.72 per 1,000 gallons is to be used when the bill reflects unusual consumption which can be attributed to eligible leakage on customer's side of the meter. This rate shall be applied to all such consumption above customer's historical average usage.

(C) SECURITY DEPOSIT

Not to exceed one-twelfth (1/12) of the annual estimated charge for residential service or one sixth (1/6) of the annual estimated charge for commercial service, or seventy-five dollars (\$75.00), whichever is greater.
