RULES AND REGULATIONS

- I. Rules and Regulations for the Government of Sewerage Utilities, adopted by the Public Service Commission of West Virginia, and now in effect, and all amendments thereto and modifications thereof hereafter made by said Commission.

APPLICABILITY

Applicable within entire territory served.

AVAILABILITY OF SERVICE

Available for general domestic, commercial and industrial service.

(I) USAGE CHARGE

First 2,000 gallons	\$12.96 per 1,000 gallons
Over 2,000 gallons	\$12.96 per 1,000 gallons

(C,I) MINIMUM BILL

Minimum Monthly Bill	=	\$25.92
3,400 Gallon Monthly Bill	=	\$44.06
4,000 Gallon Monthly Bill	=	\$51.84

(I) UNMETERED CHARGES FOR RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL CUSTOMERS

\$38.88 per customer per month (based on 3,000 gallons)

CONNECTION CHARGE

A connection fee shall be charged as follows:

Domestic, Commercial and Industrial Users: A sewer tap fee of \$200 dollars, or actual cost, is hereby established for all new service connections to the wastewater facilities which do not require the crossing of a street or highway; a tap fee of \$800, or actual cost, is hereby established for all new service connections to the wastewater facilities which require the crossing of a street or highway; provided however, that the Common Council may provide appropriate resolution for alternate sewer tap fees for new service connections which are made during construction projects which extend the lines into neighborhoods not previously receiving service.

DEPOSITS FOR SERVICES

Not to exceed one-twelfth (1/12) of the annual estimated charge for residential service or one-sixth (1/6) of the annual estimated charge for commercial service, or fifty dollars, whichever is greater.

RETURNED CHECK CHARGE

A service equal to the actual bank fee assessed to the Board or a maximum of \$25.00 will be imposed upon any customer whose check for payment of charges is returned by their bank due to insufficient funds.

SEWER ADJUSTMENT FOR WATER LINE LEAKS

The Town shall make an adjustment for sewer if there is a water service leak from meter to residence or commercial structure. Adjustment shall be based on comparison of prior year usage for the same month at residence requesting sewer adjustment. No adjustment shall be made if leak is within dwelling, for example: water heater leak, commode leak, or other water facilities within dwelling or commercial structure that created leak.

DELAYED PAYMENT PENALTY

The above schedule is net. On all accounts not paid in full when due, ten percent will be added to the net current amount unpaid. This delayed payment penalty is not interest and is to be collected only once for each bill where it is appropriate.

LEAK ADJUSTMENT INCREMENT

An increment charge of \$0.30 per 1,000 gallons shall be charged for all sewer billed in excess of the customer's historic usage.
