RULES AND REGULATIONS

- I. Rules and Regulations for the Government of Sewerage Utilities, adopted by the Public Service Commission of West Virginia, and now in effect, and all amendments thereto and modifications thereof hereafter made by said Commission.

STEP 1 RATES

Effective March 12, 2016 for 60 months

APPLICABILITY

Applicable in entire territory served.

(C) AVAILABILITY

Available for domestic, commercial, industrial (except unusual industrial waste) sewer service.

(C,I) RATES

For all customers with metered supply

First	3,000 gallons used per month	\$ 14.08 per 1,000 gallons
Next	2,000 gallons used per month	\$ 12.75 per 1,000 gallons
Next	3,000 gallons used per month	\$ 9.59 per 1,000 gallons
All Over	8,000 gallons used per month	\$ 7.78 per 1,000 gallons

(C,I) MINIMUM CHARGE (Customers with a metered water supply)

(Based on 3,000 gallons used per month) \$ 42.24 per month

(N) FLAT-RATE CHARGE (Customers with a non-metered water supply)

(C) DEFERRED PAYMENT AGREEMENT

In accordance with West Virginia Public Service Sewer Rule 4.8.b.10:

A sewer customer who has been notified that water service is to be terminated for nonpayment of sewer bills shall be given the opportunity to enter into a deferred payment agreement, provided that such customer has demonstrated an ability to pay in installments. The customer shall be informed at the time a disconnect notice is issued of the option for a reasonable payment plan. The terms of such deferred payment agreement are available upon request.

(N) TAP FEE

The following charges are to be made whenever the utility installs a new tap to serve an applicant.

A tap fee of one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) will be charged to customers applying for service before construction is completed adjacent to the customer's premises in connection with a certificate proceeding before the Commission. The pre-construction tap fee will be invalid after the completion of construction adjacent to an applicant's premises that is associated with a certificate proceeding.

A tap fee of three hundred fifty dollars (\$350.00) will be charged to all customers who apply for service outside of a certificate proceeding before the Commission for each new tap to the system.

Effective March 12, 2016 for 60 months

(C) RETURNED CHECK CHARGE

A service charge of twenty five dollars (\$25.00) or the actual bank fee, whichever is lower, will be imposed upon any customer whose check for payment of charges is returned by the bank for any reason.

INSPECTION FEE

A fee of twenty dollars (\$20.00) shall be charged for inspection of hook-up to the system.

(N) DISCONNECT CHARGE/RECONNECTION CHARGE/ADMINISTRATIVE FEE

Water service will not be restored until all past sewer bills have been paid in full and all accrued penalties plus a disconnection charge of twenty five dollars (\$25.00) have been paid.

There shall be a twenty five dollar (\$25.00) reconnection charge paid prior to restoration of water service which has been previously disconnected for any reason. All fees are to be paid at the Utility office or by mail. No monies will be collected by operators in the field.

INCREMENTAL COSTS

An amount not to exceed \$7.01 per 1,000 gallons is to be used when a bill reflects unusual consumption which can be attributed to eligible leakage on the customer's side of the meter. This rate shall be applied to all such consumption above the customer's historical average usage. The Utility shall establish a non-discriminatory policy regarding this provision for leak adjustments.

STEP 2 RATES

Effective after March 12, 2021

APPLICABILITY

Applicable in entire territory served.

AVAILABILITY

Available for domestic, commercial, industrial (except unusual industrial waste) sewer service.

DELAYED PAYMENT PENALTY

The above schedule is net. On all accounts not paid in full when due, ten percent (10%) will be added to the net current amount unpaid. This delayed payment penalty is not interest and is to be collected only once for each bill where it is appropriate.

DEFERRED PAYMENT AGREEMENT

In accordance with West Virginia Public Service Sewer Rule 4.8.b.10:

A sewer customer who has been notified that water service is to be terminated for nonpayment of sewer bills shall be given the opportunity to enter into a deferred payment agreement, provided that such customer has demonstrated an ability to pay in installments. The customer shall be informed at the time a disconnect notice is issued of the option for a reasonable payment plan. The terms of such deferred payment agreement are available upon request.

TAP FEE

The following charges are to be made whenever the utility installs a new tap to serve an applicant.

A tap fee of one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) will be charged to customers applying for service before construction is completed adjacent to the customer's premises in connection with a certificate proceeding before the Commission. The pre-construction tap fee will be invalid after the completion of construction adjacent to an applicant's premises that is associated with a certificate proceeding.

A tap fee of three hundred fifty dollars (\$350.00) will be charged to all customers who apply for service outside of a certificate proceeding before the Commission for each new tap to the system.

RETURNED CHECK CHARGE

A service charge of twenty five dollars (\$25.00) or the actual bank fee, whichever is lower, will be imposed upon any customer whose check for payment of charges is returned by the bank for any reason.

INSPECTION FEE

A fee of twenty dollars (\$20.00) shall be charged for inspection of hook-up to the system.

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STEP 2 RATES (Continued)

Effective after March 12, 2021

DISCONNECT CHARGE/RECONNECTION CHARGE/ADMINISTRATIVE FEE

Water service will not be restored until all past sewer bills have been paid in full and all accrued penalties plus a disconnection charge of twenty five dollars (\$25.00) have been paid.

There shall be a twenty five dollar (\$25.00) reconnection charge paid prior to restoration of water service which has been previously disconnected for any reason. All fees are to be paid at the Utility office or by mail. No monies will be collected by operators in the field.

INCREMENTAL COSTS

An amount not to exceed \$7.01 per 1,000 gallons is to be used when a bill reflects unusual consumption which can be attributed to eligible leakage on the customer's side of the meter. This rate shall be applied to all such consumption above the customer's historical average usage. The Utility shall establish a non-discriminatory policy regarding this provision for leak adjustments.
